The documentary *"Persephone, Goddess of the Seasons"* is the result of an artistic collaboration between 10 organizations for people with disabilities, from 5 European countries (Greece, Spain, Hungary, Sweden, Ireland), as part of the Lighthouse Network of the EASPD, with the initiator and coordinator being the Cerebral Palsy Greece / Open Door. The presentation at the Festival will be based on the film but will be enriched with theatrical scenes performed by the Open Door theatre group.

This award-winning performance is accessible to all audiences, regardless of language or background.

11:30– 13:00 "Look What I Found"

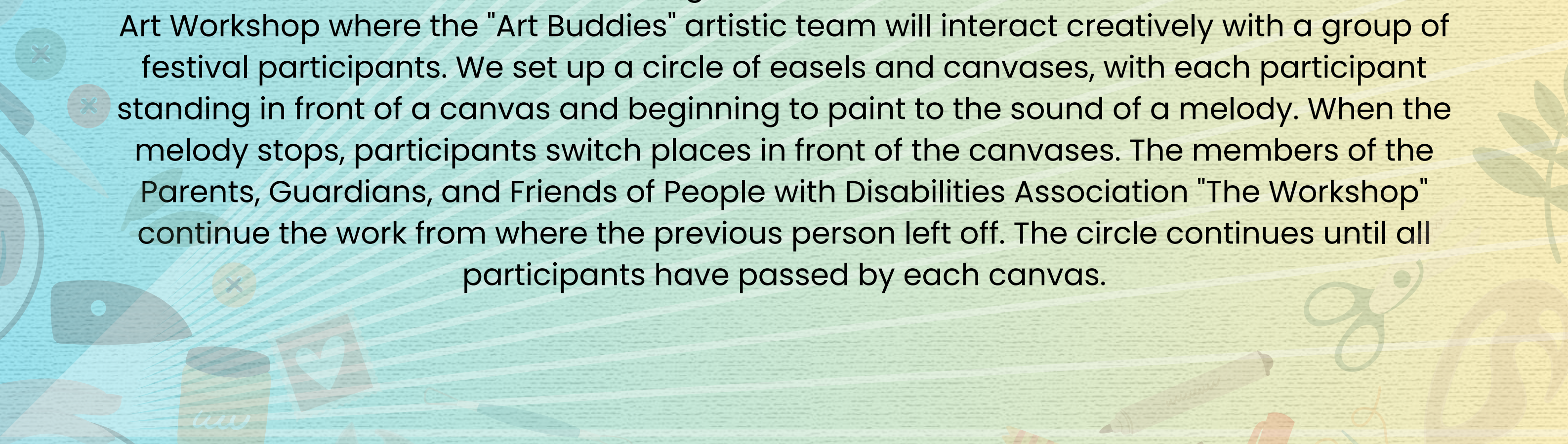

The name

Neofytos Cultural Organization is named in honor of a thirteen-year-old Neofytos Antoniou, from Limassol, son of Christiana and Neoklis Antoniou, who passed away on 09/10/2013 due to Astrocytoma.

One of the primary goals of the Neofytos Cultural Organization is to combat the social exclusion often faced by individuals with disabilities. This mission is deeply rooted in the religious tradition of our island, as Saint Neofytos secluded himself in a cell. Thus, the organization's name is intricately linked to the issue of exclusion. Furthermore, the etymology of the name originates from the ancient Greek verb φύω/φύομαι, meaning "to grow" or "to be born," reflecting the organization's conceptual and philosophical essence as something new and evolving. This significance transcends language barriers, as reflected in the consistency of the name across English (Neophyte), French (Néophyte), and German (Neophyt).

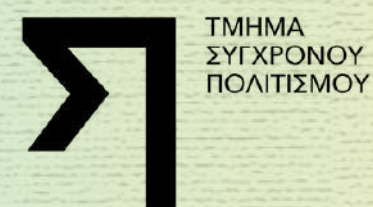


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
